

The 32nd Annual Imperial Owners Statewide Meet & Show* San Simeon-Cambria, CA April 15, 16, 17 & 18, 2015



This year's 32nd Annual sponsored by the Imperial

Imperial Owners Meet is Owners Association of

Northern California, and will be held in San Simeon and Cambria, CA - on the central coast in San Luis Obispo County, halfway between the Los Angeles and San Francisco Bay metropolitan areas, about 4 - 4 1/2 hours by car either way, depending on traffic.

The 2015 meet will start by checking into your hotel* - on Wednesday afternoon, April 15th. Because we were not able to get enough rooms at one hotel in the area, this year you have your choice of two hotels - the San Simeon Lodge at a bargain rate about two miles from Hearst Castle - near the ocean, or the more exclusive Cambria Pines Lodge on a wooded hill above Cambria, CA, at a higher price. Both venues are about 5-6 miles from each other. See the Schedule and Registration information for more details.

Our Thursday and Friday tours this year will include Hearst Castle and the Estrella Warbirds Air and Auto Museum in Paso Robles, with a picnic sandwich lunch at the museum. The Friday night reception will be held at the San Simeon Lodge outdoor pool area, and Saturday's awards banquet will be held at the Cambria Pines Lodge. Saturday's car show will be in downtown Cambria at the Santa Rosa Church parking lot. An added feature this year will be an invitation to other pre-1980 Mopars (Chrysler, DeSoto, Dodge, Plymouth) to join us - but they will be in a separate voting category.

DIRECTIONS TO CAMBRIA-SAN SIMEON (mileage approximate)

From the South, take I01 north from the Los Angeles Metropolitan area 200 miles to San Luis Obispo, exiting at the Highway 1 signs in downtown San Luis Obispo to Morro Bay (14 miles). From Morro Bay, continue north past Cayucos to Cambria about 20 miles - and San Simeon about 5 miles further.

A - For those traveling to Cambria Pines Lodge, do not enter old town Cambria itself but continue on Hwy 1 up the hill to Burton Drive (signal), make a right - Burton bends around to the right; proceed past Patterson Place about 1/4 mile making a left at the next street - and you're at the Lodge. For those proceeding on to San Simeon Lodge, continue on Hwy 1 past Cambria about 5 miles to San Simeon - the Lodge is the last hotel-motel on the right hand side of the Hwy. 1 frontage road (9520 Castillo, San Simeon) at the north end of town before the bridge leaving San Simeon. Google or Mapquest for more specific instructions.

<u>From the San Francisco Bay area,</u> take Hwy 101 south of San Jose 160 miles (from San Jose) to Paso Robles, CA. Then - see paragraph **B** below.

From Sacramento & points north, take I-5 190 miles south through Stockton, Tracy, and Coalinga to Kettlemen City, take the Hwy 41 exit to Paso Robles. Hwy. 41 merges with Hwy 46 in about 20 miles - then continue west on 46 about 25 miles to Paso Robles, making a left at the 101 exit south. Then - see paragraph **B** below.

B - for both Bay Area and Sacramento travelers, going south on Hwy 101, take the Cambria/ Hearst Castle - Hwy 46 exit - about 2-3 miles south of the 101/46 intersection at Paso; then take 46 west about 30 miles to Cambria. See the rest of directions to hotels, paragraph **A** - as <u>italicized</u> above. Google or Mapquest for more specific instructions.

CAR SHOW AWARD CLASSES, AWARDS, BALLOTING, & TIES

Classes & Awards: Imperial classes will be: Pre-war to 1954; 1955, 1956, 1957, 1958, 1959, 1960, 1961, 1962, 1963, 1964, 1965, 1966, 1967, 1968, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1972, 1973, 1974, 1975, 1981-1983, 1990-93. The "Other Mopar" Class will be combined for all pre-1980 Chrysler products other than Imperial. Classes are subject to change - based upon the number of cars of each year registered by March 17. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & Honorable Mention will be awarded for each class, and there will be awards for Long-Distance, Hard Luck, Ken Woods Memorial (most improved), President's Cup, & Best of Show.

Ballots & Ties: Each entrant who registers shall be entitled to 1 ballot (vote). All ballots must be turned in at the ballot box at Saturday's show by 1 pm. If there is a tie for any class or award, 1/4 point will be added for each day tour (1/4 Thursday, 1/4 Friday) completed by each vehicle. The Ballot Committee shall consist of 1 club member appointed by the president of each club (IOANC, SCIOI), plus a 3rd member agreed to by both club presidents. In the event of a tie for an award, the Ballot Committee will verify tour participation and add the 1/4 tour points, but if the tie is still not broken, or the Ballot Committee cannot make a determination on an award, the final decision for that award will be made by agreement between the 2 club presidents.
