In order to insure against the possibility of objectional detonation in 1963 Chrysler 300J model engines, the basic ignition timing was changed to 12-1/2° B.T.C.

This change should be made on any C-300J models in dealer inventory and on any C-300J model brought in for service.

Please make notation of the new specification in your Chrysler-Plymouth Service Bulletin No. 63-34, dated December 26, 1962.

The new basic ignition timing of 12-1/2° B.T.C. began with engine date code 3-1-62. Refer to Chrysler-Plymouth Service Bulletin No. 63-1A, dated December 19, 1962.
